ATA Carnets provided by Production Freight for Customers own use

ATA Carnets being handed over by Production Freight for road operation by our clients or our clients designated agents or operators are done so on the understanding that the correct procedures will be followed (full instructions available on request) with the Carnet receiving the correct export and import customs authorizations on the correct counterfoils and vouchers at the necessary border crossings. Border points being closed or unattended will not be considered a reasonable excuse for non-completion of this.

Any documents not completed correctly or out of sequence will incur a £250.00 administrative fee from Production Freight which will be charged to the customer in addition to any fines or fees levied by the UK Chamber of Commerce or any other recognized regulatory body either within or outside of the UK.

OCEAN / AIR / ROAD - INCLUSIVE

In the event of the Customer or their appointed handlers, agents, suppliers or partners loading a container, vehicle or other transport unit, it is the Customers responsibility to ensure that they or their appointed handlers, agents, suppliers or partners have ensured that all goods have been properly and sufficiently prepared, packed, stowed, secured, labelled and/or marked within the container, vehicle or other transport unit and that the preparation, packing, securing, stowage, labelling and markings are appropriate to ensure safe and secure transit during any operations or transactions affecting the goods and the characteristics of the goods.

It is the responsibility of the Shipper to make the Freight Forwarder aware of the presence of any potentially Dangerous or Hazardous Goods prior to the loading of any transport unit.

In all instances the quotations are subject to all cargo being able to be securely and safely stackable onto trucks, ocean containers, aircraft containers or any other means of transport during the transit operation

LITHIUM BATTERY WARNING – Independent Maritime Organization tests show a single damaged or defective battery can experience uncontrolled temperature increases that can spread throughout a shipment. In IMO tests the overheating batteries have released explosive gases that, when ignited, have blown the doors off cargo containers before becoming engulfed in flames. Any items that are planned to be shipped which contain any Lithium Batteries must be declared to Production Freight at the time of quotation as a separate quote may have to be provided for shipping the Lithium Batteries independently. As well as a risk to life it is an offence in Law to not declare the presence of Lithium Batteries in your consignment.

We have assumed that where applicable all wood products and packing materials you have used comply with ISPM15 photo-sanitary rules and regulations.
